General Use Guidelines and Rules

Within the limits of any of the Pecan Grove Municipal Utilities District (PGMUD) parks, it shall be unlawful for any person to do any of the following acts, except as may be otherwise provided:

1. To hitch, fasten, lead, drive or let loose any animal or fowl of any kind; provided that this shall not apply to dogs when led by a cord or chain, not more than six feet long. Animal waste is to be cleaned up by owner.
2. To ride or drive any unlicensed motorized vehicle upon any drive or street in any park of the PGMUD.
3. To ride or drive any motorized vehicle upon any walk or trail in any park or on the District's levee, unless otherwise designated by sign. This includes but is not limited to motorcycles, cars, trucks, ATV's, go-carts, and golf carts.
4. To drive any vehicle across the curbs, sidewalks, grass, lawn or anywhere else within such park, other than upon the roads, streets, parking lots, and designated parking areas designated for that purpose.
5. To drive any vehicle carelessly, disregarding the rights or safety of others or without due caution and at a speed, or in a manner so as to endanger, or be likely to endanger, any person or property. Vehicles may not be driven in excess of posted speed limits.
6. To park, or occupy more than one space, vehicles or trailers upon the grass, lawn or anywhere else within any park, other than in those areas designated for that purpose.
7. To park vehicles or trailers anywhere but within and between the visible lines designating a single vehicle parking space of any parking lot of the PGMUD parks, when such visible parking space lines have been placed upon such parking lots.
8. To park any vehicle or trailer in any parking lot or parking area so as to obstruct, block or hinder ingress or egress of such parking lot or parking area.
9. To carry or discharge any firecrackers, rockets, torpedoes, or any other fireworks, or air-guns or slingshots; discharge any firearm; or carry any firearm, except those persons duly authorized and licensed by the state to carry a concealed handgun in accordance with the provisions of the Texas Concealed Handgun Act.
10. To damage, cut, break, injure, deface or disturb any tree, shrub, plant, rock, building, cage, pen, monument, fence, bench or other structure, apparatus or property; or to pluck, pull up, cut, take or remove any shrub, bush, plant or flower; or to mark or write upon, paint or deface in any manner, any building, monument, fence, bench or other structure.
11. To cut or remove any wood, turf, grass, soil, rock, sand, gravel or fertilizer.
12. To leave garbage, cans, bottles, papers or other refuse elsewhere than in trash receptacles provided therefore. Bringing in outside garbage is prohibited.
13. To participate in any activity when the PGMUD believes such activity may create a danger to the public or may be considered a public nuisance. The PGMUD Board may designate particular locations within park areas for specific activities.
14. To camp overnight in any PGMUD park.
15. To consume alcoholic beverages.
16. To play or bet at or against any game which is played, conducted, dealt or carried on with cards, dice or other device, for money, chips, shells, credit or any other

- representative of value, or to maintain or exhibit any gambling table or other instrument of gambling or gaming.
- 17. To use or speak any threatening, abusive, insulting or other language constituting "fighting words" in any of the parks, and no person shall commit, in any such parks, any obscene, lewd or indecent act or create any nuisance.
- 18. To disturb in any manner any picnic, meeting, service, concert, exercise or exhibition.
- 19. To distribute, post, place or erect any advertising, handbill, circular, bill, notice, paper or other advertising device.
- 20. To sell or offer for sale any food, drinks, confections, merchandise or services unless such person has a written agreement or a permit issued by the PGMUD Board.
- 21. To practice, carry on, conduct or solicit for any trade, occupation, business or profession or to circulate any petition of whatsoever kind or character without approval of the PGMUD Board.
- 22. To start a fire of any kind, with the exception of controlled pit fires in District-owned and maintained barbeque pits located in District-owned parks and facilities.
- 23. District-owned picnic shelters are available for use by District residents. Residents may contact the Parks Manager to reserve a shelter for a specific date and time. In the event a shelter is not in use, any District resident is free to use the shelter. However, reservations for shelter use will take precedence over unreserved usage of the site at all times. Residents are responsible for cleaning up the shelter after they have used it. A deposit or fee may be charged for use of the shelter.

Violation of any of the PGMUD guidelines or rules related to parks will subject the violator to a fine of up to \$5,000 per violation or criminal penalties, including imprisonment, or both. Parking outside of the designated parking areas will subject the violator to a fine of up to \$5,000 per violation or towing at the violator's expense, or both.

Pecan Grove Municipal Utility District Parks

Park Rules

1. All dogs must be on a leash at all times. Horses are prohibited. Animal waste is to be cleaned up by the owner.
2. Glass bottles of any type are prohibited.
3. Alcoholic beverages on park grounds are prohibited.
4. Firearms and fireworks of any type are prohibited.
5. Damaging or defacing any park property is strictly prohibited.
6. Driving outside of designated parking areas or driveways is strictly prohibited.
7. Speed limit is 10 MPH (or as stated) at all times.
8. Abusive or offensive language is not permitted at any time.
9. Advertising or solicitation is not permitted.
10. Selling of any concession items is not permitted.
11. Parks are for use by PGMUD residents only.
12. It is unlawful to violate any of the park guidelines and rules.
13. Individuals, groups and organizations within the PGMUD that wish to use the athletic fields must reserve them with the Parks Manager (YMCA) 281-341-0791.
14. Reservations for the picnic pavilion by individuals, groups and organizations within the PGMUD may be made with the Parks Manager (YMCA) 281-341-0791. Reservations will be accepted no earlier than 30 days in advance. Without reservations, use is on a first come, first served basis. A deposit or fee may be charged for use of the District's levee.
15. No open fires or burning of any kind, with the exception of controlled pit fires in District-owned and maintained barbeque pits located in District-owned parks and facilities.
16. Violation of any of the PGMUD guidelines or rules related to parks will subject the violator to a fine of up to \$5,000 per violation or criminal penalties, including imprisonment, or both. Parking outside of the designated parking areas will subject the violator to a fine of up to \$5,000 per violation or towing at the violator's expense, or both.
